



Her research interests include learning analytics, artificial intelligence in education, and technology in education. She is the head of the Ateneo Laboratory for the Learning Sciences. In 2021, Dr. Rodrigo received the Distinguished Researcher Award from the Asia-Pacific Society for Computers in Education (APSCE) and is President-elect of APSCE.

Beyond Traditional Learning: How AI is Reshaping Resilient Educational Practices

Prof. Dr. Abd. Karim AliasUniversiti Tenaga Nasional (UNITEN)

Dr. Abd Karim Alias is a former Professor of Food Technology at the School of Industrial Technology, Universiti Sains Malaysia (USM) and the former Director of the Centre for Development of Academic Excellence. He taught at USM for over 28 years, starting in 1994, before retiring in October 2022. In addition, he held several administrative positions, including Deputy Dean, Director of CDAE, Senate member for many years, and Senate representative on the university's Board of Governors. Currently, he serves as a Distinguished Fellow at UNITEN and Universiti Malaya's Adjunct Professor.

In 2008, he received the Ministry of Higher Education of Malaysia's prestigious National Academic Award for teaching. He has received Malaysia's Rising Star 2015 Award (Highest research citation in Agricultural Sciences/Food Science & Technology), the Malaysia Research Star Award for four consecutive years (2016, 2017, 2018, 2019), and the World's Most Influential Scientific Minds by Clarivet Analytics. On a national level, he is a Master Trainer for AKEPT and a writer for the Malaysia Education Blueprint 2015-2025 (Higher Education). As co-chairman of the National Technical Committee, he led the development of Malaysia's MOOC. Dr. Karim is an ardent supporter of utilising the Internet as an alternative learning and teaching medium. He has created and maintained a variety of teaching-related portals, websites, online courses, and blogs. As of July 2023, his 469 instructional videos on YouTube have received over 1.62 million views from over 190 countries, with an estimated 70,000 watched hours and over 8600 subscribers. At IUCEL2022, he was awarded two prestigious national awards, i.e., the Higher Education e-Learning Maestro Award and the Best Trendsetter Award.

Linda has extensive experience of working in varied international contexts and has a passion for supporting learners.

As Director of the Centre for Online and Distance Education, Linda leads a team of 44 Fellows who are thought and practice leaders in online and distance education. Linda has extensive experience of working in varied international contexts and has a passion for supporting learners and teacher development. Building on over 25 years' experience of leading and supporting high quality learning and teaching, course design and senior leadership, Linda has led the Centre for Online and Distance Education since 2017. Linda came to the University of London following a role as Dean and Head of London Campus of Glasgow Caledonian University. Prior to this Linda held roles as Dean of the Royal Docks Business School and Associate Dean Education and International Lead at the University of East London, and Head of Initial Teacher Education at Anglia Ruskin University. Linda's original area of research was in Theoretical Chemical Physics, but in the last 25 years, Linda has focussed on online assessment, teacher development, mathematics and science education.




